POSTER SESSIONS GUIDELINES

(revised on 11 June 2009)

INTRODUCTION

The poster sessions offer a valuable opportunity for authors to present their papers and interact with the audience. It is important to design the poster in such a way that:

- i) it provides a clear overview of the study,
- ii) it includes sufficient material to be self-explanatory and to initiate discussion and questions.

DATE AND TIME

Poster Session I 16 July 2009 at 17:00 – 19:00

All poster presentations will be open for exhibition in this session.

Poster Session II 18 July 2009 at 14:00 – 17:00

To share the presentation material of plenary speakers with local professionals and researchers who are not able to participate fully in the symposium, in addition to plenary presentation, the slides of all plenary presentations will be exhibited in this separate poster session.

POSTER SESSIONS DETAILS

For Poster Session I, authors should set up their posters before the afternoon sessions on 16 July 2009. The poster numbers are indicated on the symposium program. At least one author of each paper should be present during the poster session to interact with participants. Authors should arrive 15 minutes before Poster Session I starts.

For Poster Session II, authors should send their PowerPoint or presentation slides to secretary@isttt18.org when ready, or latest by July 10 please. We will print the slides and post them. Authors are also welcome to bring hard copies of their presentation and post them themselves. If they choose to do so, they should send a note to secretary@isttt18.org and inform us.

ISTTT18 provides 2 display boards (each 2 m in height and 1 m in width) for each paper (see Figure 1). Each paper can use 2 standard A0 size (841 mm in width x 1189 mm in height) posters for display. The organizer will provide tapes to mount the posters. There are

no provisions for making posters at the Symposium, receiving, or storing posters.

LAYOUT SUGGESTIONS

- The material on the poster should be arranged in columns, typically starting at top left and ending at bottom right.
- Text and illustrations should be readable from 1 m away.

CONTENT SUGGESTIONS

- Title, poster and paper number, author names, institutional affiliation
- Introduction / Objectives
- Methodology, statistical or Analytical Methods
- Summary / Results
- Conclusions
- Future Directions
- Acknowledgements
